Supervision of Students in the Yard Before and After School

Staff supervise children in the school grounds before school from 8:50 to 9:00 am and after school from 3:20 to 3:35 pm. Outside of these times supervision is the responsibility of parents/guardians. If children want to use the playground (even during the times above) they must be supervised by their own parent or guardian.

Message from the Principal

Prep Children

It is terrific to have our prep students at school full time now. We look forward to them enjoying all that school has to offer.

Absences from school

Did you know that it is the duty of the parent/s to notify the school if your child is absent from school?

A commitment to attendance and being on time is important in preparing students for roles and responsibilities in adult life.

0 - 6 days absence in a semester (half a year) is in the normal range of absence. Anything over 6 days absence and attendance rate is below average.

There is a link between regular school attendance and positive social, emotional and learning outcomes for students.

There is also correlation between poor attendance and student disengagement and being exposed to 'at risk' behaviours.

If your child is away, you can:

- Call the school on 9311 1325 and leave a message.
- Complete an online absence form that you can access on the school's website www.albionps.vic.edu.au Click on the Absentee Form on the right hand side of the home page and complete the details and submit the form online.
- Write a note and send it to school with your child when they return.

We want all of our students to make the most of the educational opportunities that are provided at school so they can reach their full potential.
